


Vocabulary Notes: We are going to learn some wordy wording of wordiness – so Get Ready For IT!

Prep:


- Take out your notebook!



7. Many <u>diffident</u> men have lost their beloveds to a bolder rival.




8. There was a <u>discrepancy</u> in the judges' choice for who should be named the winner, so they gave all

16. After a day of hard work, nothing is better than taking a long <u>repose</u> in a hammock.




16. The dog and the baby <u>repose</u> together on the floor.




17. The coach showed a lot of <u>temerity</u> in arguing with the umpire, knowing it could get him ejected.
